

Xello Steps for Jump Start High School Seniors:

Follow these steps to:


- (a) Complete some "quizzes" to learn about your strengths and interests
- (b) Explore some "careers", "majors" and/or "schools/colleges"
- (c) Select your three favorite "careers", "majors", and/or "schools/colleges"
- (d) Identify available scholarships that match any of your favorites
- (e) Start building your resume.
- 1. Open ClassLink
- 2. Type "Xello" in the search bar
- 3. Click on the link



4. Complete the inventory quizzes under the "About Me" column:




- 5. To look at specific careers, colleges/schools, or majors click the links under "Explore Options".
- 6. Click the "heart" next to your favorite <u>3 careers, next to your 3 favorite schools</u>, and the next to the <u>3 majors</u> you are most interested in obtaining in college. These "favorites" will be used by the Xello search engine to recommend the scholarships that are a good match for you.




7. Here's where you find the heart to click by your favorite 3 careers:




- 8. Scroll to the bottom of the career page to find the majors that are aligned with that career.
