



SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

To receive the WMHS Jump Start Scholarship, I agree to complete (with parental/guardian support) the following requirements by May 1, 2025:

- Attend and graduate from WMHS during 2024-25
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and submit the Student Aid Report
- Complete applications for and be accepted by at least one Florida college, university, or technical school
- Review and update regularly MY 3-YEAR JUMP START PLAN. Meet regularly to work with your Jump Start Coach, WMHS teachers, or other adults to complete the following PLAN components:
 - 1. A Career Path description, including target occupations, colleges to attend, and 3-year outcomes expected
 - 2. At least 25 hours of documented community service and/or paid work experience
 - 3. Completion of at least two year-long courses in AVID or a career and technical education (CTE) major, such as Agricultural Science.
 - 4. At least five (300-word) POWERFUL LEARNING EXPERIENCE REFLECTIONS, which address the questions in the fill-able PLAN form. Due to Ms. Palko by April 15, 2025.
