Introduction:

The members of the Wildwood Wildcats Booster Club are pleased to announce our Annual Scholarship and Grant Program. In May, we will award up to \$10,000 in scholarships and grants to WMHS graduates who have been: (a) Admitted to an accredited university, college, or postsecondary technical college/school, and (b) Attended at least one of the Free Application for Federal Financial Assistance (FAFSA) Night Workshops at WMHS.

Criteria:

1. Applicants must have applied and been accepted at a university, college, or postsecondary technical college/school. Please attach your acceptance letters. Applicants who have applied but have not yet been officially accepted will also be considered with supporting documents.
2. Applicants must be graduating seniors of Wildwood Middle High School.
3. Decisions will be based on a completed application and transcript, which describes your academic choices and performance in high school, financial need, community service, extra-curricular activities, and work experience. Any supporting documents submitted with the application will also be reviewed.

Instructions:

1. On or by March 15, 2025, please submit to Ms. Palko in the Guidance Office, the following:
 - a. Completed application
 - b. Supporting documentation of: (a) your acceptance at one or more colleges, and (b) completion status of the 2025-26 FASFA form
 - c. Your high school transcript.
2. In early April, please plan to participate in a brief (15 minute) interview with members of the Scholarship and Grant Committee. This will be scheduled by Ms. Palko's office.
3. All information provided in your application will be held in strict confidence by reviewers. All applications will be shredded once the review is completed.
